

SPI- All Species Muskegon Lake

- 1) **You need to have registered and paid online or pay in cash 15 minutes before launch time to be able to fish in the tournament. We are launching at Fishermans Landing. You cannot go past the pier-head into Lake Michigan. We will be launching at 8:00am and the tournament ends at 1:00pm (must be done fishing and by dock).**
- 2) **One or two adults (17 years and older) per boat.** A two-person team may have up to 2 additional kid anglers (max one that is 16- 11). We are trying to make this a family atmosphere and want to help promote fishing to future generations!!
- 3) **Livewell checks** will be done.
- 4) **For weigh in you will select your largest fish to weigh in. You may weigh in up to 2 of each game species (bass, pike, walleye, salmon, trout,...), 2 total non-game species (carp, sheephead,...) and up to 10 panfish (any combination of perch, bluegill, crapie..).**
- 5) If you try to weigh in too many of species we will remove an additional fish of that species.
- 6) There will be a 1 pound per minute late **penalty for any boat coming in late** to the designated weigh in site. You must be within 75 yards of launch.
- 7) **Total weight determines the winning team.**
- 8) **All State and local regulations must be followed. If you are ticketed during the event it will be an automatic disqualification.**
- 9) Participants in **Sportspersons Ministries International** tournaments are expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship and courtesy.
- 10) **Alcohol or drugs will not be permitted or tolerated** at our events and will result in automatic disqualification.
- 11) **Max of 8 rods can be used at one time, no more than 2 hooks per rod. Artificial and live bait can be used.**
- 12) **No fishing will be allowed within 50 yards of an anchored competitor's boat.** A boat is considered anchored if it is held in a stable position by a rope attached to an anchor or by a power pole, with the trolling motor in the up position.

Note: We strongly recommend that you wear a life jacket especially when you are traveling fast.
